
The AMOS Conference brings together leaders, researchers, technologists, system developers and operators from industry, the military, and academia involved in the many facets of space situational awareness.






CALL FOR PAPERS

Abstract Deadline: April 1, 2017
 Notification of Acceptance: May 15, 2017

The more than 100 technical papers offered as oral presentations or poster presentations are the core of the annual AMOS Conference. The rich array of presenters cover research and development ongoing in the many fields related to space situational awareness such as adaptive optics and imaging, orbital debris, astrodynamics, and non-resolved object characterization. The AMOS Program Committee reviews all submissions from the annual Call for Papers and selects those that best meet the scientific and technical goals of the conference. Submissions are also encouraged from national and international undergraduate and graduate students. Proposals for special sessions, such as panels and invited oral presentations are also considered.



Abstract Format and Submission

The Program Committee has scheduled both oral and poster sessions. The abstract of both oral and poster papers are published in the same manner in the conference materials. On the electronic submission form, authors will be asked for their presentation format preference. Submitted abstracts must report new information and not previously published or presented at a national or international scientific meeting, unless there is a substantial update of data.

The abstract should clearly describe key innovations, new research, and developments related to space domain awareness. For a complete list of categories, visit the Speakers page of the conference website.

Papers will be selected on the basis of the submitted abstract. The abstract should clearly outline the paper's major elements of interest, its originality, and be non-marketing in scope. Papers not selected for oral presentation may be selected for display as poster papers.

Each abstract must include the following information:

- Title of paper
- Author name(s), titles, affiliations, and email addresses
- Presenting author name and short biography
- Short synopsis of the paper (300 words in length)
- Suggested session(s)
