

CALL FOR PAPERS

Abstract Deadline: April 1, 2016 Notification of Acceptance: May 15, 2016

The Program Committee has scheduled both oral and poster sessions. The abstract of both oral and poster papers are published in the same manner in the conference materials. On the electronic submission form, authors will be asked for their presentation format preference. Submitted abstracts must report new information and not previously published or presented at a national or international scientific meeting, unless there is a substantial update of data.

We encourage submissions from international, and undergraduate and graduate students pursuing a degree in a science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) at an accredited college or university. International and student participants will receive a reduced conference fee.

Proposals for special sessions, such as panels and invited oral presentations are also welcome. Please indicate your request in the comments field of the abstract form.

The abstract should clearly describe key innovations, new research, and developments related to space domain awareness. For a complete list of categories, visit the Speakers page of the conference website.

Abstract Format and Submission

Papers will be selected on the basis of the submitted abstract. The abstract should clearly outline the paper's major elements of interest, its originality, and be non-marketing in scope. Papers not selected for oral presentation may be selected for display as poster papers. Abstracts will be published in the 2016 AMOS Conference abstract booklet. If your abstract requires public release approval, ensure to complete prior to August 15. The papers will be published in the 2016 AMOS Conference proceedings.
