**Opening Keynote Speaker:** Mr. Frank Rose, Deputy Assistant Secretary for Space and Defense Policy, US Department of State (invited)

Moderated by Peter Marquez of Orbital Sciences, this panel will explore the status of the 2011 U.S. Space Policy Implementation. What is the status of collaboration and SSA data sharing on the international level? Where are the opportunities and challenges?

Invited panelists will include representatives from organizations and stakeholders for Space and Space Situational Awareness Policy, including: White House Space Policy, Air Force Space Policy, Intelligence Community Space Policy, and USSTRATCOM.

12:00 p.m. **Session II: International Space Situational Awareness and Collaboration**

**Keynote Speaker:** Maj. Gen. James K. "Kevin" McLaughlin, Director, Space Operations, Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations, Plans and Requirements, US Air Force (invited)

This session will focus on mitigating the risk of operating in space by exploring the value of Space Situational Awareness collaboration.

The Coalition panel will be comprised of members from Australia, Canada, the United Kingdom and the US and will explore the SSA priorities for each organization; the status of SSA operations; and how the international SSA community interacts with the US SSA community. Invited speakers will include representatives and stakeholders on these topics to include: Australia Royal Air Force, (DG) Space, Royal Air Force Fylingdales, and US Strategic Command (USSTRATCOM).

Jana Robinson, European Space Policy Institute, will lead an international discussion of members representing organizations from Japan, France, Germany and South Korea. This panel will explore international SSA priorities, opportunities, and identify where partnerships are mutually beneficial for collaboration.

2:00 p.m. **Session III: Commercial and Civil Space Situational Awareness**

Lt Col Travis Blake, DARPA /TTO-Space Systems, will lead a panel with representatives from commercial and civil Space Situational Awareness stakeholders, as well owner/operators, in a discussion exploring how commercial industry contributes to SSA and the potential added value; discuss the priorities of safety of operations when balanced with business and fiscal responsibilities, how does the civil space sector intersect with commercial, and where does space traffic management fall within SSA.

Invited representatives from commercial and civil organizations will include: NASA, NOAA, FAA, Intelsat, Paradigm, and Providence Access.
